Brambles' Chairman, Graham Kraehe AO, said: "The Board is delighted that shareholders have approved the scheme of arrangement to implement the demerger of Recall Holdings Limited as an independent, separately-listed company. Recall can now move forward with a dedicated Board, leadership team and strategic focus on delivering sustainable value for shareholders."

Subject to approval of the Scheme at the Second Court Hearing, Recall shares are expected to begin trading on the ASX on a deferred settlement basis on Tuesday 10 December 2013.

While shareholders approved the Executive Benefits Resolution put to the General Meeting, the Board acknowledged the number of votes cast against the resolution.

Mr Kraehe said: "Brambles has a strong track record of shareholder support for its remuneration policies as evidenced by the 96.5% vote in favour of the Remuneration Report at our recent AGM. The Board is determined to preserve this record and has taken careful note of the specific issues raised by shareholders in relation to this resolution and remains committed to regular and transparent consultation with its shareholders."
