


Sustainability Highlights FY23

Building on our global leadership position in sustainability, Brambles has achieved tangible progress against its ambitious 2025 sustainability targets.

Regeneration is about delivering life's essentials every day, but in a nature and people positive way. Reuse, resilience and regeneration are at the core of this vision and are embedded in Brambles' business.

Implementing sustainable practices and certifying new sources in South Africa

Brambles' strategic approach to achieving our Forest Positive Targets includes a regenerative forestry programme that enables the sustainable growth of two trees for every one used. Brambles has recently obtained 10 new timber farms in South Africa, which cover a total of 3,950 hectares with roughly 3.85 million trees, through its CHEP Sub-Saharan Africa business.



Regeneration in action

The Tabasco Regeneration Forestry Project radiates as a model of regenerative transformation.

In the heart of the Tabasco state in Mexico, a remarkable journey of regeneration is unfolding. The project is not only shaping and revolutionising our approach to timber procurement but also making our regenerative vision a reality with the environmental benefits and social value that is being generated through this flagship project.
